COSTS

All programs are \$45 per day (plus a surcharge where applicable).

MEMBER SPECIALS

All programs \$40 per day per child (plus a surcharge where applicable).
Full week \$190 per child or \$185 per child for two or more children.

ENROLMENT

Please ensure that you enrol your child at the earliest opportunity, as places are often limited.
Your enrolment cannot be guaranteed if lodged close to the commencement date.
Registrations received without payment will not be guaranteed.
Receipts will be available and can be collected on the last day attended. Confirmation letters will not be sent. You will be contacted only if a place is unavailable.
Please note that Receipts for Childcare Benefit are issued as standard receipts.
Every family may be eligible to receive a percentage of Childcare Benefit for our Holiday Programs.

BEFORE AND AFTER CARE

Because of lack of 'take-up', the before and after-care options have been withdrawn.
Please note that The CHIP Centre will not necessarily be staffed before 10.00am or after 4.00pm.

WORKSHOPS

Workshops are from 10.00am – 4.00pm each day. Please refer to the program for details. Some workshops recommend that students wear appropriate clothing – please see program descriptions.

YEAR LEVEL RANGE

CHIP Holiday Programs are designed to cater for primary and early secondary school level students. Generally all workshops are suitable for students in years Prep to 8, but this may vary depending on the activity, and will be noted in the program description

LUNCH

All children are expected to bring a packed lunch and morning tea. We may make additional refreshments available. Please let us know if this is not acceptable.

WITHDRAWAL FEES

Confirmations of bookings are not sent out.
A withdrawal fee of \$20 per child is applicable if a booking is withdrawn before Monday 12th January.
From Monday 12th January, no refund is available for withdrawal.

CANCELLATION OF WORKSHOPS

If there are insufficient numbers booked to attend a workshop two days before it is due to be run, it will be cancelled. If you pay for a session that is subsequently cancelled, you will be fully refunded for that session. It is rare for a session to be cancelled.

PLEASE USE THE GENERAL CHIP HOLIDAY PROGRAM APPLICATION FORM TO ENROL IN SCHOLAR WORKSHOPS

CHIPs Scholar Workshops prepare students for scholarship examinations or accelerated program entry.

In the morning sessions the following areas will be covered, (including trial exams) with a focus on time management and multiple-choice strategy: Mathematics includes a variety of questions similar to the ones most likely to appear on exams. Both basic skills and advanced problem solving will be tested.

English covers such areas as spelling, grammar, comprehension, written expression, improving sentences and planning stories..

General Ability tests students' aptitude in a variety of areas such as vocabulary, logic & spatial reasoning and general knowledge.

In the afternoon sessions, scholars will participate in challenging, though less formal, activities. During this time, individuals and small groups of scholars may be involved in discussions related to their morning's work.
