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
## *Gifted Resources News*



Whether you are just at the beginning of your child's education or mid primary or in secondary school, if you are looking to make sense of the terminology this is the session where you can ask for clarification.

*Gail Byrne* is a psychologist and is also a teacher and Coordinator of Individual Differences. For the past twelve years, she has served as Chairperson of the CHIP (Children of High Intellectual Potential) Foundation. She has many years of experience working with children who may not be experiencing success in the classroom for any number of reasons. She specializes in the assessment of children.

Gail has coordinated Special Education Departments and Gifted Programs in a number of schools and is particularly skilled at understanding the ramifications of an assessment and explaining to teachers and parents how best to work with the child in the classroom and at home.

Gail has completed doctoral studies in the underachievement of gifted children whilst her Masters in Education concentrated on curriculum differentiation and meeting children's needs in the classroom.




